To: Peter Rogers - Housing Authority of the County of Santa Cruz, Maintenance Coordinator

During pre-bid walkthrough it was observed that Building #201 is a "Post & Beam" type of construction with panel section inserts as the exterior walls. Project details tell us to remove both interior and exterior wall plywood and insulate the walls and then install drywall at the interior and ply sheathing & then cement plaster on the exterior. (See Wall Detail #1 on sheet A280.)

The existing wall studs are on edge and will not allow R-13 insulation to be properly installed. (See Insulation Schedule on sheet A280.) The question is this; Are the existing walls to remain or will they need to be replaced with the proper wall thickness needed and therefore need to be properly attached to the foundation and the roof system? If the walls are to be re-framed, will Structural details be issued prior to bidding? Please advise.



Inquiry was about how to achieve insulated walls with existing narrow post and beam walls, with existing studs installed on edge.

New insulated stud walls are to be built out in thickness to include or partially include existing posts. New sill plates for stud framing are to be attached to existing slab and are to be positioned up to edge of the existing slab. As a result the new stud wall may be positioned partially in the same plane as the posts. This will provide the desired wall thickness for insulation.

Due to hazmat considerations partial demolition and examination of existing conditions in walls has not been possible. Exact construction and composition of existing walls were not able to be identified. During demolition and hazmat abatement the structure will be evaluated and recommendations made by a structural engineer. If any improvements to the structure are called for they will be added to the scope of work.

Question #1: The Housing Authority will respond about providing an allowance to cover possible repairs and replacement of roof plywood sheathing as may be required.

Due to hazmat considerations partial demolition and examination of existing conditions in walls and ceilings has not been possible. Exact construction and composition of existing walls and ceilings were not able to be identified. During demolition and hazmat abatement the structure will be evaluated and recommendations made by a structural engineer. If any improvements to the structure are called for they will be added to the scope of work.

Question #2: The proposed 2x furring and dry wall will run between the existing trusses as shown. The furring will be notched around the existing nailer on top of trusses. Please note that the new 2x framing are not structural members but furring to provide space for insulation and attachment for new drywall ceiling.

Question #1: I cannot find any mention of fire alarm system; either deferred, scope or specified. California Fire Code 902.2.3 states "A manual and automatic fire alarm system shall be installed in Group E occupancies with one or more rooms used for day care purposes." Is there to be a fire alarm scope of work included with the bid?

Answer: The fire alarm system is a deferred approval item. Fire alarm submittal from sub to be submitted for approval by County Building Department prior to installation.

Question #2: Other than a note to relocate existing telephone equipment and blocks, there are 26 new data/voice outlets with no cabling. Is there to be cabling installed? Answer: The Symbols and Abbreviations states that the telephone/data outlets shall have 3/4" conduit back to the punch down blocks located in the office. The telephone and data cabling shall be by others (the Owner's IT personal). Individual home runs are required at each telephone/data outlet, combining home runs for several outlets is not allowed.
